Additional Comments, notations, and abatement information (including date): As always, the NCOSH Review Commission maintains an excellent and safe work environment. The only minor issue that I found was that the fire extinguishers were not currently inspected (they are three months out of date) due to the person formerly in charge of inspection leaving. They will inspect these extinguishers as soon as they learn the process for doing so.
