

Minutes of Meeting Boiler Safety Bureau Management

Date/Time: May 3, 2012 / 1:30 p.m.

Location: Old Revenue Building, 6th Floor Conference Room (B611)

Bureau Chief – Jack will be attending the National Board Members Meeting June 11 through 18 in Nashville and is scheduled for Review Team Leader training in Columbus July 31 through August 2.

Jack announced that the National Board is now accredited by the International Association for Continuing Education and Training to issue Continuing Education Credits (CEU).

There was discussion of “blast pots”, pressure vessels loaded with sand that is pushed out using compressed air. Several rental units have been inspected recently and were found to be in poor repair and without the proper over pressure protection.

Assistant Bureau Chief – The week of October 15 was selected for the annual physicals and eye exams. There is a work shop on welding procedures that is in development for training that same week.

The electronic form for online inspection requests has been revised and is in use.

Boiler will be assigned four vehicles that were being returned to motor fleet management by the Elevator Bureau.

We have been looking at the operation of water bath heaters that indirectly heat fuel gas and propane. These are going to be discussed with the inspectors and an exemption may be added to the Rules.

The Supervisors were asked to discuss the dangers of heat stress at their next inspectors meetings.

The administrative hearing regarding the Cease Operation Order that was issued for a Roxboro cleaner has been moved to August 2012.

Final evaluations for the inspectors are complete and have been reviewed for consistency. The supervisors will meet with each inspector in May.

Inspector Supervisor East Report – Don Kinney was released to work on his own April 23, 2012.

Andrew Gunto has been assigned as the AI at Edwards and back up at Morris, Ramco and AC Corp.

Inspector Supervisor West Report – Salisbury Machine will have a review by the National Board on May 31 for the renewal of their R stamp.

Greg did an R stamp review at Wayside Truck Repair that resulted in a renewal recommendation.
