Additional Comments, notations, and abatement information (including date): Red EXIT signs failed to illuminate when test button pressed: 3rd Floor at solid door to lobby (#56); 2nd Floor at door to N.E. stairwell (#28); 1st Floor outside men's room (#5). No EXIT sign or emergency lighting at door from lab. to lobby. **N.E. Stairwell**: Light fixtures: on landing between 1st and 2nd floors, ON but unable to test due to test button missing; at door to 2nd floor, fixture OFF, pilot light OFF, and no response to test button; at door to 4th floor, one tube OFF, one tube glowing pink, did not illuminate when test button pressed. **N.W. Stairwell**: Light fixture on landing between Lower Level and 1st floor: test button broken/unable to test, and lens broken; fixture at door to 2nd floor ON but did not illuminate when test button pressed. Emergency lights (#6) above door to men's room on first floor, and (#1) opposite elevators on lower level emitted sound (abnormal) and did not illuminate when test button pressed.
