#### PREFACE

#### OPERATORS MANUAL

THIS OPERATORS' MANUAL IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF SOUND JUDGMENT AND GOOD COMMON SENSE. PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AND SUGGESTIONS:

- 1. OBSERVE GROUND CONDITIONS--MAKE CERTAIN THE RIDE IS ON FIRM FOOTING.
- 2. CHECK FOR OVERHEAD OBSTUCTIONS--ESPECIALLY POWER LINES AND TELEPHONE LINES.
- 3. BE AWARE OF WEATHER CONDITIONS WHICH MIGHT AFFECT THE SAFETY OF CREW AND CUSTOMERS.
- 4. ALWAYS BE AWARE OF LOCAL RULES, LAWS, AND CUSTOMS.
- MAKE CERTAIN THAT ALL OPERATORS ARE FAMILIAR WITH OPERATING PROCEDURE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS.

#### OPERATORS MANUAL

## DAILY INSPECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. CHECK SUPPORT JACKS UNDERNEATH FUN HOUSE PLATFORMS. RETIGHTEN AND ADJUST AS NECESSARY.
- 2. INSPECT LOCKER BOARDS AND POLES HOLDING GLASS IN PLACE. MAKE SURE THEY ARE SECURE.
- 3. CHECK ALL HANDRAILS FOR PROPER PINNING.
- 4. MAKE SURE THE STEPS ARE IN GOOD CONDITION AND IN THE PROPER PLACE.
- 5. MAKE SURE THAT ALL PASSAGE WAYS ARE FREE OF ANY OBSTRUCTIONS THAT MIGHT CAUSE A FALL.
- 6. MAKE SURE THAT ALL R-KEYS AND BRACES HOLDING DISTORTION MIRRORS ARE IN PLACE AND SECURE.

## END OF DAILY INSPECTION

AFTER COMPLETION OF THE DAILY INSPECTION YOU ARE NOW READY TO BEGIN OPENING PROCEDURES.

TURN ON ALL NECESSARY BREAKERS.

### OPERATIONS PROCEDURE

THIS OPERATIONS MANUAL WILL ASSUME THE FUN HOUSE HAS BEEN PROPERLY ERECTED AND THE DAILY INSPECTION HAS BEEN PERFORMED AS CALLED FOR IN THE MANUAL PROVIDED.

ONE RESPONSIBLE PERSON IS REQUIRED TO OPERATE THIS FUN HOUSE. THIS PERSON IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TAKING TICKETS AND HELPING TO GUIDE PEOPLE WHO BECOME CONFUSED IN THE GLASS MAZE. THIS PERSON MUST KEEP PEOPLE FROM CARRYING SHARP INSTRUMENTS SUCH AS UMBRELLAS AND PRIZE MIRRORS INTO THE FUN HOUSE. THESE ARTICLES MUST BE LEFT OUTSIDE. THIS PERSON MUST ALSO STOP PEOPLE WHO ARE RUNNING INSIDE THE MAZE.

### OPERATING CONDITIONS

STEADY OR HEAVY RAIN:

KEEP THE PUBLIC SLOWED DOWN. REMOVE LARGE AMOUNTS OF WATER FROM PLATFORMS.

#### THUNDERSTORMS:

IF A THUNDERSTORM CONTAINING LIGHTNING IS APPROACHING, CLEAR THE FUN HOUSE OF ALL PATRONS, THEN OPERATOR.

## MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

- 1. KEEP FLOORS CLEAN OF DEBRIS AND OBSTACLES DAILY.
- 2. CHECK R-KEYS AND PINS HOLDING MIRRORS DAILY.
- CHECK LOCKERBOARDS AND POLES DAILY AND REPAIR IF NECESSARY.

## SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

IN CASE OF LOSS OF POWER, EMERGENCY LIGHTS WILL COME ON. SHUT OFF MAIN DISCONNECT, SO THAT THE FUN HOUSE DOES NOT COME BACK ON UNEXPECTEDLY. OPERATORS SHOULD ENTER THE FUN HOUSE AND CALMLY REMOVE THE PUBLIC FROM IT SLOWLY.

BEFORE STARTING UP AGAIN, ONE OPERATOR SHALL GO THROUGH THE FUN HOUSE AND CHECK FOR PEOPLE AND OBSTRUCTIONS.
